
Notice of Annual General Meeting

COPA National's Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held online at 6 pm Eastern Time, on September 7, 2023.

Following a meeting held on July 4, the Nominating Committee will not be recommending the election of any new directors to the Board of Directors. Instead, it will recommend earlier ratification of the sitting members, for the following reasons:

- The Nominating Committee believes that it is important to revise *l'article 5* (*Membres des Règlements*) of the organization by-laws to allow for membership of organizations rather than individual members in order to reflect the practice of other national Francophone organizations in Canada and ensure more efficient management of membership.
- The Nominating Committee plans to revise the section of by-laws relating to the composition of the Board of Directors to ensure greater national representation. It would have nine (9) members, including at least three (3) from Ontario, one (1) from Atlantic Canada and one (1) from Western Canada.
- Once the by-laws have been revised, COPA National will call a special meeting to adopt the amended versions.

"The Board of Directors worked steadily during the past year to hire a new Executive Director, update policies, adopt a macro-agenda, and develop a risk management grid. All this was done at the same time as overseeing the auditing of two financial years: the first ending September 30, 2022, and the second ending March 31, 2023. We look forward to presenting the work accomplished at the Annual General Meeting."
